## Wax aroma DIFFUSER

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

DMJ-0002F Junior dipping kit and DMJ-0002B Junior colouring kit or

DMC-0002B Combi 2B

DPW-00119 Composite wax T119 or

other paraffin wax

DPW-00011 Coating wax

KLP-24... Colour tablets

ZAT-02001 Aroma basis

YZS... Perfume oil / fragrance oil

ZAT... Aromatic sticks

Balloon (small and round, but not a water balloon)

Heat the wax to 70°C - 75°C in a suitable dipping urn.

Fill the ballon with cold water and knot the nozzle to seal it.

Hold the balloon by this knot and briefly dip it into the molten wax. Dip to just below the ring. Repeat this dipping process, waiting every layer for the wax to cool. You can gently support the balloon with your other hand while you wait, but do not put it down. This will crack the layer of wax. Your hand will therefore have to support the weight of the balloon for the full duration. So don't make it too big and heavy (1 litre = 1 kg).

Once the wax side is thick enough (after dipping at least 10 times), dip once or twice in coloured coating wax for a harder outer layer to finish the diffuser. Then hold the knotted nozzle of the balloon over a sink and cut it off.

Please note: pressure means that the water will spray out. Remove the empty balloon and gently press the wax diffuser down with both hands to form a flat base plate on the underside. The wax bottle should not tingle.

To fill the diffuser, add the desired fragrance to the aroma base and cut the flavoring sticks to the desired length and place in the bottle. The aroma develops optimally when the rods are reversed once a week.
