Latex casts

- 1. Liquid latex contains ammonia as a solvent. Ensure sufficient ventilation during use.
- 2. Clean the object and possibly coat it with a lubricant like Vaseline or a soap solution
- 3. Use a brush to apply liquid latex to the object, or dip it directly into the latex.
- 4. Allow the latex to harden/dry and repeat the process at least 5 times or until the desired cast thickness is reached.
- 5. After the final dipping/brushing, put down the object in such a way that a 'collar' forms around the underside. The cast can be suspended from this collar when filling it.
- 6. The drying time depends on the ambient temperature. Higher temperatures speed up the drying process, while lower temperatures slow it down.
- 7. Remove the object from the cast by rolling the cast off it.
